Changes are cached and then automatically synchronized in the background when a user is online. Contributor also provides a convenient way to store and organize Microsoft Outlook® emails and attachments in SharePoint document libraries for team access.

Colligo Contributor unlocks the power of SharePoint by replicating content to a local encrypted data store, eliminating reliance on constant server access. Its secure two-way synchronization engine with robust conflict resolution functionality ensures that only authorized users gain access to libraries and lists. Contributor's intuitive drag-and-drop interface is tightly integrated with Microsoft Office® desktop applications so it requires little to no training or support. Here are some proven use cases that demonstrate how Contributor delivers added value for SharePoint users:

Sales Executives – Sales executives are often disconnected while on the road, at client offices, or at conferences. With Contributor, they can bring the latest account information and sales materials on their laptops. After prospect discussions, they can easily complete account forms and sales reports. When back at the office changes are automatically synchronized to SharePoint. They can also drag-and-drop emails from Outlook to Contributor, to sync and store account communications.

Accountants & Consultants – CPAs and consultants can spend the majority of their time at client offices, where the Internet can be slow or not available. Contributor allows them to remain productive on site – with access to the client information they need to deliver superior service. And by allowing them to sync and store relevant account emails in SharePoint, Contributor helps streamline compliance with document retention requirements.

Project Teams – With offline access to project documents, forms, templates, and metadata, team members can easily locate, access, and update project details while working from home, boardrooms, or while traveling. Contributor supports updates to workflow metadata and project document versions. Project emails can be easily tracked in SharePoint. In some cases, users achieve sufficient performance improvements that they use the client while online as well.

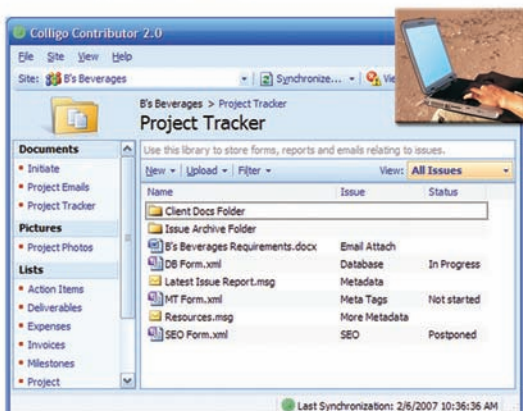
Easy for SharePoint Administrators to Deploy

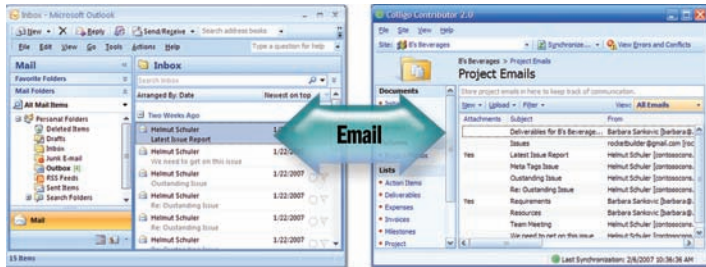

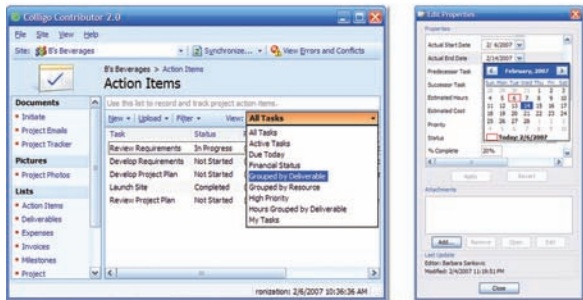

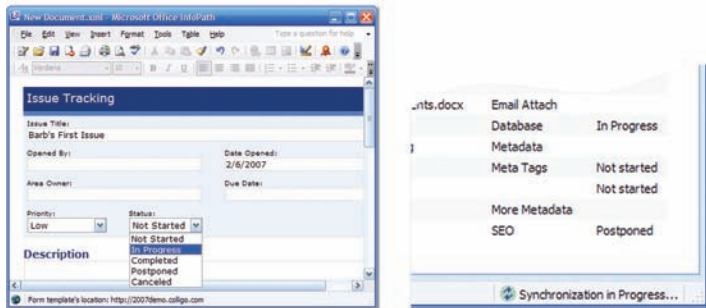
Email in Microsoft Outlook

Background Sync

Email Drag-and-Drop

With a simple email drag-and-drop from Microsoft Outlook, Contributor captures message fields including To, From, CC, Sent date, Subject, and Attachments. Users can then sync and access emails in SharePoint libraries based on the metadata. By deploying Contributor to laptop and desktop users, SharePoint Administrators can easily migrate email content management to SharePoint.

Custom Metadata & Views

Content is organized using the same standard or custom views defined on the server. Variables ([Me] and [Today]) enable offline views to change depending on the user and date. Multi-value lookups are also supported. Full access to metadata ensures that offline users still benefit from workflow features.

InfoPath Forms & Document Libraries

Documents and InfoPath forms are edited simply by double-clicking and saving back to the document library. New documents can be created offline from the same template as the SharePoint site. Documents can be copied between Contributor and desktop by drag and drop. Users can access multiple content types and form templates in libraries with Contributor while offline.

Custom & Standard Lists

Colligo Contributor delivers offline access to custom lists and many standard lists including events, issues, links, contacts, announcements, tasks, and agendas. List items can be entered and edited with just a few clicks.

Synchronization & Version Resolution

Users can select specific documents, libraries, or entire SharePoint sites. Content selection can be initiated within Contributor, using the “Connect to Contributor” button in Internet Explorer, or with a simple drag-and-drop from the browser. Content is kept up to date with automatic or manual synchronization. Microsoft Word® compare and merge supports elegant conflict resolution upon synchronization of documents modified by multiple users.
